Consultants working with the City and the project advisory committee have recommended improvements for the Oakridge transportation system, including road and intersection enhancements, sidewalk infill, installation of marked pedestrian crossings, construction of multi-use paths, and improved transit service.

Recommended improvements include a reconfiguration of Oregon Highway 58 that would reduce the number of travel lanes on the highway in order to provide a turn lane, bike lanes, and sidewalks without needing to add right-of-way.
