### **Council Experience**

#### Mayor - Oakridge, Oregon

I was Mayor for the City of Oakridge for one year. I was immediately tasked with leading a hiring process with my Council, to hire two Pro Tem City Administrators, and then a permanent City Administrator. In this process, I worked closely with each of the Councilors and our City Attorney as well as Departments Heads. I managed Public Affairs and many leaderships tasks during the biggest wildfires this community has ever seen, the Cedar Creek Fire of 2022. During that time, I worked daily with at least a hundred fire management leaders that changed out periodically, and leaders and partners around the County and State for approximately two months. I worked with Councilors and Staff to hold a Townhall with the hot topic of the Public Safety Fee. I also formed two important subcommittees: the WAC Renovation Committee and the Special District Joint Sub-Committee. These are some of the things that were larger that were seen, but there are many more duties I took on in the year, such as networking with many Mayors and elected officials, both towns, County and State. I attended dozens of meetings each month and work hard to promote Oakridge. One of the things I am most proud of as Mayor, is the teamwork approach that I promoted within our Elected Officials and City Staff. Although we didn't always agree, I strived to bring respect and trust in a positive environment.

In the three years I was a City Councilor, I held the President role for the Council. During this time, I dug in to learn and understand our city's budget. I attended multiple Elected Officials classes and trainings all over the State including webbased trainings and in-person.
