Commissioner Kordosky asked for more information on the reason we couldn't put the original conditions on the Order and Findings regarding the wording of the sign.

Louis explained that we went a little far at the last meeting, as the commission you can regulate size, location, color, and those kinds of things. You cannot regulate words on a sign. He wanted to put a green cross on his building and that is considered free speech under the First Amendment, so he is allowed to put up his green cross. We cannot dictate any wording, we asked him to do that and we cannot do that. He is going to add his green cross, the State of Oregon has determined that as medicine, that is one of the reasons he wanted the cross, so people can identify his business.

Commissioner Custer said most of the green crosses he has seen are all about the same standard size.

Louis said our hands are tied on the issue and we have to follow state law.

Commissioner Kordosky said when he left here at the last meeting Mr. Mack was in agreement to not put up a green cross.

Louis said we can't hold him to that. It is not a legal request.

Commissioner Custer said the City Administrator caught it early before anything came back on us.

Commissioner Kordosky asked why we even have a sign code if we can't regulate the words on the signs?

Louis said the First Amendment says we can't regulate what goes on the sign.

Commissioner Custer said as long as it's not offensive or threatening we can't do anything.
