Dennis Patterson 47871 W 1st Street- The services Inbound provides is legendary and he says to give it to them.

5.0 Discussion Items

Sign Ordinance

Rick said this was on our goal list last year as well. One of the issues in question is the sign code is everywhere in the book and we want to combine it all into one chapter. What Rick did in this memo is anywhere you see sign regulations he highlighted them. They are in quite a few different articles.

Commissioner Custer asked what would be required to consolidate all the various sign language in to one ordinance.

Rick said Article 22 is the sign code and if we combine it all into that one section with each district having its own regulations in there.

Commissioner Custer said the Article 22 sign code is much more detailed.

Rick explained how the sign ordinance is written right now and how it is all over the place. We would like to have it all in one section of the zone code.

Commissioner Custer wanted to discuss electronic signs like the high school has, it seems like a lot of them are prohibited and he would like to see them discussed, we need to look into the future and get with the times.

Rick said this would be the time to discuss this.

Commissioner Custer asked Rick what does ODOT say about the reader board types, they are fine as long as they conform to the loomins and the changing of the sign?

Rick said he didn't ask about the changing eight times a day because they were going to follow that. He has seen other billboard signs that change more than eight times a day.

Commissioner Custer said we are going to see more and more particularly down along the highway businesses that are going to be wanting those.

Right now our code disallows them totally and we need some action on that.

Commissioner Whitney agrees, we need to evolve with the times.

Commissioner Ofsthun said it is in the code regarding not changing more than eight times a day on the animated signs, moving signs.

Rick will bring back a proposed sign code in Article 22.

Commissioner Custer would like to look at sandwich board signs, right now they are not allowed.

Rick said he will look into electronic signs, get ODOT's rules on animated signs, reference ODOT's minimums and set brightness standards and look into the schools sign and sandwich board signs. Rick will send examples to everybody.

Commissioner Custer would like to know what constitutes a window sign.
