Each spring I cringe to see what the date will be for the pick up. If it is before Easter I send messages to all my family members who will be coming to oakridge for Easter. I tell them to please overlook the gross junk in many of the yards; that our city leaders don't read the calendar when planning things. It should be relatively easy to be sure that the amnesty event is completed before Easter. Hint: Easter is early in 2018, it is April 1st. Let's not plan for junk amnesty to occur later in April. Perhaps do it in March. I've also noticed that the summer concerts in the park sometimes coincide with things like The Country fair or other music venues. We have only a few concerts in the summer. 

Q4 Which project do you feel the City Should pursue?



Q5 What did you base your decision on? (Check all that apply)




