## **RESOLUTION NO. 01-2002**

## A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING BUSINESS LICENSE FEES AND REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 7-92

**Section 1.** Pursuant to the authority contained in Section 6 of Ordinance No. 855 adopted by the City Council on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of February 2002, and approved by the Mayor on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of February 2002, business license fees within the City of Oakridge shall be as established herein.

Section 2. LICENSE FEE. The non-refundable annual license fee stated as provided in this resolution shall accompany each application for a business license or for renewal of a business license.

Section 3.Special License Fees. For the following businesses the license fee shall be:

Carnival	\$ 75.00 per day
Circus	\$ 75.00 per day
Dance held for profit	\$ 25.00 per day
•	\$ 50.00 per year
Psychic Activity performed	
for profit	\$ 30.00 per day \$ 30.00 per day
Auctioneer	\$ 30.00 per day

Carnivals and circuses must also provide for adequate and sanitary restroom facilities, on site, with separate facilities for males and females. In addition to the other fees required, if water is required for operation of the circus or carnival, a non-refundable fee of \$25.00 shall be required for turn on and turn off plus a flat fee for water usage shall be paid prior to the issuance of the license. The fee shall be for an assumed meter size that is required according to Section 25 on the water rates for commercial establishments.

Section 4. General License Fees. Any person operating a business in the City not otherwise established herein and as delineated within Ordinance No. 855 shall obtain a business license and pay an annual license fee of \$50.00 per year.

**Section 5. Delinquent License Fee.** Business license fees are due prior to December 31 of each year. For each month that the business license fee is late, a \$10.00 penalty fee will be added. No business license will be issued without the proper license fee (and penalties, if any) being paid in full.

**Section 6. Disposition of Fees.** All monies collected from the payment of the annual business license shall be solely used for economic development within the City of Oakridge.

**Section 7.** Nothing contained herein shall affect the validity of currently issued business licenses, or licenses issued pursuant to authority of Ordinances of the City or State Law.
